- Be a positive role model and ambassador for young people in hockey across Europe.
- Represent the voice young people across Europe.
- Influence and inspire other young people and adults regarding the EHFYP.
- Lead, manage and mentor EHF Youth Panel Leaders.
- To undertake an advocacy role with key adults in the EHF and European National Associations about the role played by EHF Youth Panel.
- To be the face of the EHF Youth Panel brand.

Do:

- Respond to emails within 5 working days
- Adhere to the EHFYP Terms of Reference at all times.
- Promote the EHFYP and young leaders in Europe via social media.
- Personal social media postings, blogs and tweets should at all times conform to the EHF spirit and be dignified and in good taste.

Do not:

- When on YP missions act in any way that would harm the reputation of the EHF YP.
- Personal social media postings, blogs and tweets should not be formed so that they in any way would harm the reputation of the EHF YP, and not contain vulgar or obscene words or images.
