EHF Youth Panel Committee members should fulfil the following criteria:

- Have a minimum one year's experience as an EHF Youth Panel Leader.
- Have effectively fulfilled the roles and responsibilities of an EHF Youth Panel Leader over the last year.
- Be a positive role model.
- Be under 30 years of age.

Essential requirements:

- Ability to influence and inspire other young people and adults.
- Ability to lead and manage EHF Youth Panel Leaders.
- Ability to be a coach and mentor to EHF Youth Panel Leaders.
- Excellent communication skills with both adults and other young people.

Roles and responsibilities:

- Adhere to the EHFYP Terms of Reference at all times.
- To be the face of the EHF Youth Panel brand.
- To train and mentor new EHF Youth Panel Leaders.
- To undertake an advocacy role with key adults in the EHF and European National Associations about the role played by EHF Youth Panel.
- To be an ambassador and role model advocating the role of young people in hockey.
- To be the young people's voice in the EHF and throughout Europe.
